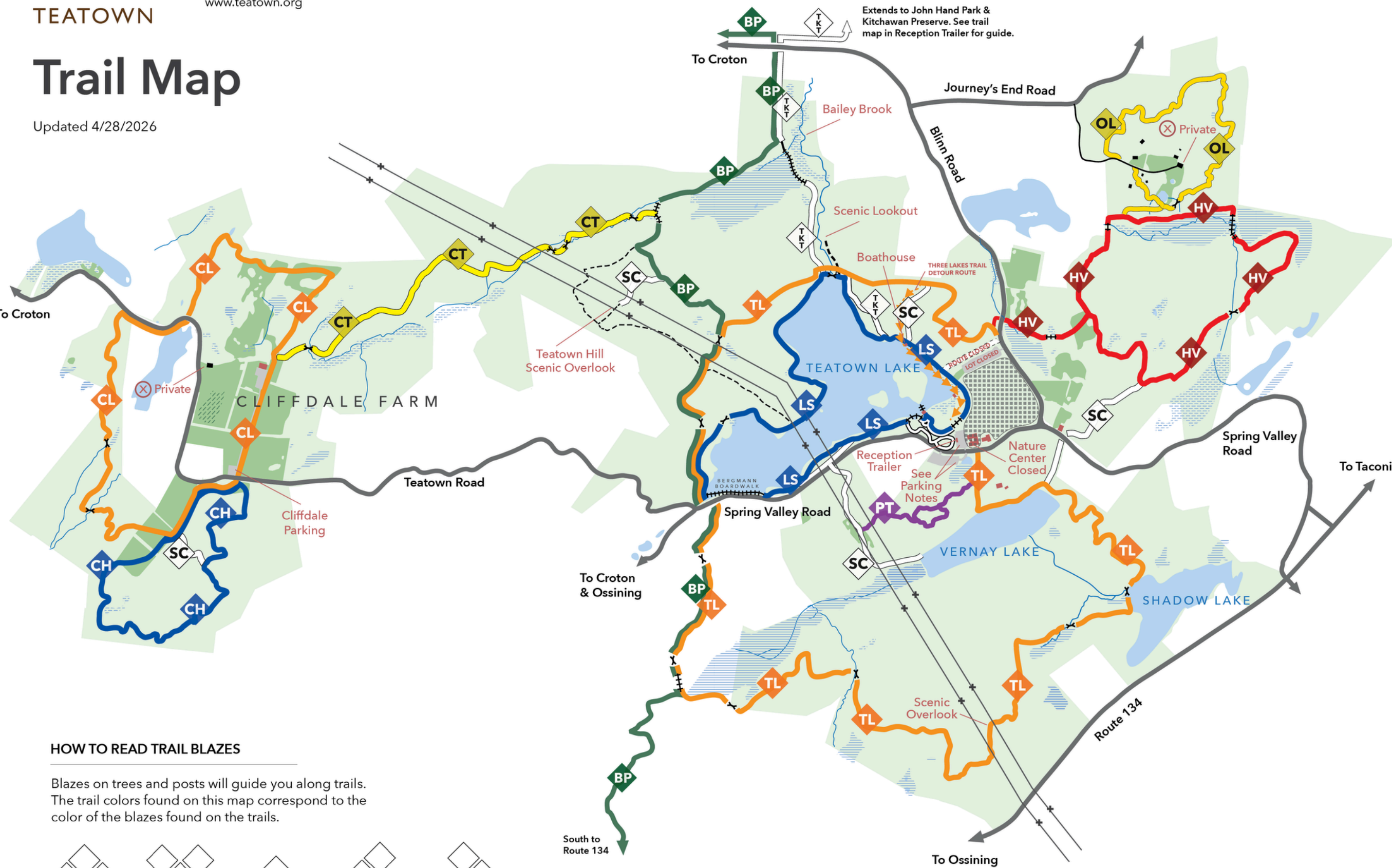

# Important Information for Visitors During Teatown's Campus Renovation Project



## Public Parking

**Nature Center Lot:** Open during first stage of construction. The lot will eventually close to the public. The closure date will be announced.

**South Lot:** Limited spots during the first stage of construction. The lot will be expanded and fully reopen to the public in 2026.

**Blinn Road Lot:** This lot is closed to the public throughout the duration of construction.

**Cliffdale Lot:** Not impacted by construction.

## Limited Facilities

The Nature Center is closed effective October 1, 2025. A temporary reception trailer is located in the Nature Center Lot. Teatown Staff are available at the Reception Desk to support visitors 7 days a week.

An ADA accessible portable restroom is located next to the reception trailer. A composting toilet is located near the trail kiosk by the Croft Pond (on the south side of Spring Valley Road). There are no public restrooms or water refill stations inside the reception trailer.

## Trail Access Changes

**Lakeside Loop:** All visitors must enter/exit the Lakeside Loop through the Wildflower Woods gate, located at the northwest corner of the Nature Center Lot. Follow signage in the parking lots to the gate.

**Three Lakes Trail:** Permanently closed between the Nature Center and the Blinn Road Lot. Temporarily closed between Blinn Road Lot and Teatown Dam.

Hikers can access the Three Lakes Trail via:

- Lakeside Loop (enter through Wildflower Woods)
- Trailhead by the Croft Pond
- Trailhead on Spring Valley Rd, south of Bergmann Boardwalk
